Solar-Electric Training available for eligible applicants

Under funding from the U.S. Department of Labor, the Comprehensive-National Electrician Solar Training (C-NEST) project will train new and current electrical workers for residential, commercial, and utility-scale solar projects. Training includes classroom and hands-on instruction directly related to solar electrical work.

What do I get?

- Tuition, books, and exam fees are sponsored by the grant
- Training in the Electrical Trade including introduction to electrical code, OSHA & safety training, first aid, and industry standards
- Training in Photovoltaic (PV) Solar Design and Installation
- Preparation and scheduling for the North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP) Entry-Level Exam that demonstrates achievement of basic knowledge of the application, design, and installation of PV systems.

Who can participate?

To be eligible for training, you must be:

- Unemployed, a veteran, a current worker (or recently laid-off worker) in the electrical, renewable energy/energy efficiency industry, or, an individual impacted by national energy and environmental policy
- A resident of Bastrop, Bell, Bexar, Blanco, Burleson, Burnet, Caldwell, Coryell, Fayette, Hays, Lampasas, Lee, Llano, Milam, San Saba, Travis, or Williamson County.
- 18 years of age or older
- Legally eligible for employment in the USA
- A high school graduate or equivalent (including documented 1 year of algebra with a passing grade)
- Able to meet industry related suitability requirements* (these criteria are described in more detail on the webpage referenced below)
- Be available to attend training and seek related employment upon completion of training

*Other eligibility requirements may apply and enrollment is subject to funding availability.
